Ford, M.M., Chair of Catholic Missiology at Catholic Theological Union in Chicago, U.S.A. He has authored several books and numerous articles, including “Acts” in *The Jerome Biblical Commentary for the 21st Century*.

Dr. Tuan Hoang, PhD, is Seaver College's Blanche E. Seaver Professor of Humanities and Teacher Education and professor of Great Books at Pepperdine University. His research primarily revolves around the intellectual history of South Vietnam from 1950-1975, as well as the history of Vietnamese refugees and immigrants.
